An invitation to present and to participate

Are you willing to share a skill or a vision? Have you searched and found something you would like to tell the world about? Do you want to benefit from the idea-producing capacities and experiences of the conference participants?

The conference includes a few general presentations (or so called key note –presentations). Most of the conference time has however been allocated for presentations and workshops given and facilitated in smaller groups (allocated times 1.5 or 3 hours each).

Send us your presentation proposal at the address to be found from the end of this brochure. Tell us your subject, the way of presenting (oral presentation or workshop) and describe the contents briefly. We aim to choose presentations and workshops so that the final program would meet the expectations of as many as possible.



The conference theme is “TA today”. Our goal is to bring TA up to date in Finland and in other Nordic countries. We also aim to explore how TA has developed, and how it is applied today in various fields, like education/teaching, supervision, psychotherapy and organisations.

The conference language will be “scandinaviska”: presentations given in Finnish are translated to Swedish if necessary and vice versa. It is also possible to use English. We will do our very best in possible translations, and we ask you to tell us your wishes considering your preferences in advance.

We also ask you to tell us your preference of the time of your presentation. We will consider your wishes according to the possibilities available. It is also possible to give presentations or facilitate workshops conjointly with a colleague.



Send us your proposal as soon as possible, however no later than 30.9.2008. We will contact you in two weeks of time, and after the deadline we will select the presentations and workshops for the conference. Details will be further discussed with selected participants.

TA 101 introductory course

The official TA 101 introductory course will be held during the two days (4.-5.2.2009) preceding the conference. The course program will cover TA’s basic concepts (egostates, transactions, existential positions, strokes, script, discounting, games, time structuring, contracts). Completed course is a prerequisite for a full membership of TA organisations. There will be no additional cost from the course for participants who have paid the conference fee.

Venue, program and time schedule

The conference will be held in Helsinki, Finland at cultural centre Sofia (address: Kallvikintie 28, internet: www.kulttuurikeskussofia.fi). The conference will start at Friday morning and it will end at Sunday afternoon after lunch. The program, the time schedule and the list of proceedings and participants will be updated constantly as we receive your proposals and wishes. You can follow the progress via our homepage www.finta.net. Information about the evening banquet will also be supplied at a later time.

Conference fees

The conference fee covers also printed materials, lunches and afternoon coffee service. Saturday’s evening banquet (50 euros) and lunches during TA 101 should be paid separately. Registration before 31.10.2008: 285€ (non-members of FinTA) and 270€ (members). Registration after 31.10.2008, accordingly 300/285€. The fee for TA 101 course only is 200€.
